The visions of Willi Sattler are grounded squarely on two feet, which is perhaps the most fertile attribute of the Sattlerhof Estate. His father, Wilhelm was a pioneer who led the then fully unknown wine region wine production on paths. It was his imitation of the production of dry wines that opened fully new perspectives for Styria. The Sattlerhof Sauvignon Blanc wines are prized for their authentic character not only by Austrian sommeliers, but by experts from Germany, Japan, Korea, USA and Scandinavia. This success story is even more impressive if one realizes that this part of the country was known as Austria's poorhouse in the 1940s. This full-blooded vintner now has a highly modern vinification facility at his disposal and continues to meet all vinification decisions personally. It is he who adjusts the press at crush, arrives first in the morning and leaves last in the evening. For him, extraordinary wines are not a matter of in which vessel they are fermented or at which temperature, but rather a matter of perfect fruit. The terroir of origin must be recognizable and the aging potential outstanding. Willi's wife Maria has been his active partner in the business for 24 years and they are now assisted by their three sons Andreas (21), Alexander (19), and Lukas (16).

Sattler works together closely with experts and takes care of vineyards for organic research. After four years of preparation, no insecticides were used in his vineyards in 2009. Despite this, he says he will not follow the present trend toward organic viticulture without inhibitions, "The climatic conditions in South Styria simply do not allow organic viticulture

without compromising fruit quality at this time." He states his realistic goal with the following words: "The vintners of South Styria have developed their estates and laid the groundwork for international recognition. It is not volume that is sought, but the sustainability of our high quality and finding the best expression for our unique terroir."

Pale green-yellow. Litchi, mandarin and coconut lend tropical flair to this wine. Cassis and red currant jelly join in on the elegant, well-balanced medium body. Herbaceous acid is nicely countered by sweet, honey-laced tropical fruit and citrus, which carry through on the finish. Good aging potential.
