The press has given him the nickname “Quality Maniac”, but Fred Loimer sees himself simply as just a vintner with courage and joy in innovation. His reputation as a highly knowledgeable and experienced oenologist was just one reason why he was awarded Falstaff Vintner of the year in 2002. Fred Loimer took over the family estate in Langenlois in 1998 and expanded it to its present size of 60 hectares.

White wine varieties dominate with Grüner Veltliner making up 50% of the vineyard area complimented by Riesling, Chardonnay, and Pinot Gris. The typical regional variety, Grüner Veltliner, is produced in all of its facets, ranging from the uncomplicated “Lois” to the traditional peppery “Kamptal” or the single-vineyard examples Käferberg and Spiegel which are sourced from old vines and vinified in wood. An insider’s tip is his Pinot Noir and when the vintage allows, Loimer also produces sweet predicated wines from Grüner Veltliner and Riesling. The construction of a new winery attracted much attention for its modern design. A minimalist black and glass cube enjoys a view of the Heiligenstein and sits over an equally stunning and expansive cellar. Loimer’s Riesling Steinmassl 2002 was awarded the Dry Riesling Trophy at the International Wine challenge in London. The Grüner Veltliner Langenlois Terrassen 2007 championed the Falstaff Grüner Veltliner Grand Prix in 2008.

Medium yellow-green. Smoky flint and pepper comprise a complex background for mango, Golden Delicious apple, and wild meadow herbs on the nose. Fresh pear, orange zest, and mango complexly flavour a full, mellifluous body. Salty minerals and plenty of sweet extract remain on the very long finish. Very dependable ageing potential.
